Membership FAQs:

All male descendants adopted sons and stepsons of members of the American Legion. and such descendants of veterans who died in service during World War 1 or since December 7, 1941, during the delimiting periods set forth in Article iv, Section 1, of the National Constitution of The American Legion or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of the American Legion. There shall be no form, or class of membership except an active membership.

Are girls or women eligible to join the sons? No. Only males are eligible to join the sons. Women who are veterans and are eligible to join The American Legion are welcome and encouraged to do so. The American legion Auxiliary was established to provide Legion Family membership for female relatives of Legionnaires.
