FINANCIAL ISSUE FOR OUR POST:

Our Post has experienced a substantial decrease in income this year due to Covid-19. The biggest issue being reduced revenue derived from building rentals. In past years, building rental income has been half of our annual revenue. Since March of this year, rental income has dried up. As a result, we have been operating in a deficit for the last four of five months -- and expect that to continue at least through the remainder of 2020. It is much easier to reduce expense vs. increasing revenue. With that in mind, there is a small way for all members to help with this, and it won't cost you anything. We all enjoy receiving the monthly newsletter; either through snail mail or via email. Email is free when Compared to the cost of the local printer to create the current 223 hard paper copies, plus postage. We are currently paying the local printer \$190 per month, as well as paying postage -- which is approximately \$.30 per copy to mail. Over a year's time, this amounts to an expense of around \$3,100 per year. We are aware that not everyone has access to email,

and we completely understand if that is the case with you. But if that's not your situation -- we would like to see as many members as possible who are currently receiving the newsletter via paper mail, switch to email delivery. This would not only save the Post considerable money, but email of course is a faster delivery method. Using email will also allow you to receive any online correspondence from us in real time. This year there have been news items which went out only by email and provided information on short notice.

Please consider making the change. Just send Peg Mullen (mullen.margarete@gmail.com) your email address, and she will include you on the next monthly newsletter email.

We all need to work together to keep our Post financially healthy during this pandemic.
