\$15.50 to \$20.50 effective January 1, 2024. As I've shared previously, right now Post 663 receives \$4.00 for every \$40.00 membership paid. As a result of the increase at the State level, the Post 663 Officers voted to increase our 2024 membership dues to \$45.00 beginning on January 1, 2024.
